well as accommodation and funds towards travel to the conference. They are invited to take part in a collaborative project related to post-secondary education.

STLHE and 3M Canada will honour the Fellows formally at an awards ceremony on June 21st. Additionally, the 2013 3M National Student Fellows will lead a Plenary at the conference that day.

This year's cohort of 3M National Student Fellows continues the legacy that began in 2012 a legacy that we know will assist many future vears of undergraduate students across Canada.
