It is the only pan-Canadian, cross-disciplinary recognition of educational leadership and excellence in post-secondary teaching. - superlative undergraduate teaching, sustained over several years.

The 3M National Teaching Fellowship is unique. Fellows receive no tangible rewards, no money or research grants. Instead, they are given a lifetime membership in STLHE and a four-day study retreat together at the Château Montebello in November. They also join a vibrant and energetic Fellowship of over 320

dedicated and inspiring leaders and teachers who have helped shape university education in Canada for almost three decades.

STLHE and 3M Canada will officially welcome these ten extraordinary university and college teachers into the Fellowship at its annual conference, hosted this year in by the Université de Sherbrooke and Bishop's University in Sherbrooke.
